Programme Overview

Welcome to the 12 month, Level 2 Wood Occupations programme.

Construction building craft occupations have a traditional role in supplying a qualified workforce to small and medium enterprises (SMEs). The vast majority of companies in the sector are small, with over 97% employing fewer than 25 people. Only 1% of sector businesses employ more than 60 people, although these firms carry out a disproportionate share of the work by value.

This programme requires the completion of a Level 2 Diploma in Wood Occupations and a Level 2 Diploma in Carpentry.

Role Profile

Wood Occupations can cover a wide range of roles including Site Carpenters, Bench Joiners and Shopfitters and can include working on a construction site or in domestic and commercial premises, to given specifications, carrying out site carpentry to first and second fixing. It may also incorporate working in a joiners shop producing wood products, to given specifications, for use by the site carpenter, such as doors, window frames and stair cases. The use of machinery in the production of products plays an important part within the joiners shop.
